### PUPIL PREMIUM FUNDING FREE SCHOOL MEALS

If you are in receipt of Income Support, Job seekers Allowance, Employment and Support Allowance, Guarantee Credit, Universal Credit or Child Tax Credit (**provided you are not receiving Working Tax Credit**) your child may be eligible for Pupil Premium funding. This is additional funding provided to support your child in school and can be spent on your child in a variety of ways. We strongly urge you to make an application, especially our new families in Reception and all of our KS1 families (even if your child already receives the universal free school meals).
