

Year 2 Spring Curriculum Overview



Outlined are the main topics that we will be learning about during the Spring term. Please don't hesitate to come and see me after school if you have any questions.

English

The areas covered this term will include: tales linked to dragons; The egg, The great dragon rescue. Which link with our topic of Explorers. Within these areas, we will be learning to:

- * Write in different styles, - poetry, non-chronological report.
- * Use adjectives and adverbs.
- * Use a range of subordinating conjunctions such as: when, because
- * Extend sentences using a variety of features.

We will also be linking our English work to our topic, R.E and Science work.

Mathematics

During our time through the spring term we will be consolidating our knowledge across the curriculum. Then through our no problem maths program we will be learning to:

- To compare amounts of money
- Using column method for addition and subtraction
- Recognise simple fractions.
- Multiplying and dividing within our times tables knowledge of our 2s, 5s and 10s.



Religion - We will begin this term by reviewing Christmas and the events after Jesus' birth. We will then move onto Parable Miracles highlighting the many miracles that Jesus performed to prove his position from God. This will explore how children can aspire to be more like Jesus in every way. Then we shall move onto Celebrations of Christianity both within the church and around the world, exploring the different religious times of the year.

Science


We will begin the term by completing our topic of Living Things exploring food chains and how habitats are all around us. We will then move onto Animals including Humans exploring how Animals and Humans are alike in many ways. We shall then move onto investigating what humans and animals need to do in order to survive by keeping fit, eating healthy and keeping clean.

Topic

Geography and History will be taught through the topic of: Explorers. We will first explore each country and identify their key features. What are their capital cities? What are the physical features of that country? What are the human features of that country? They will also then be exploring the difference and key features between cities and villages.

Art and DT will link to our Explores topic where we will be creating sculptures using different materials.
