God is always ready to listen and to talk to us.

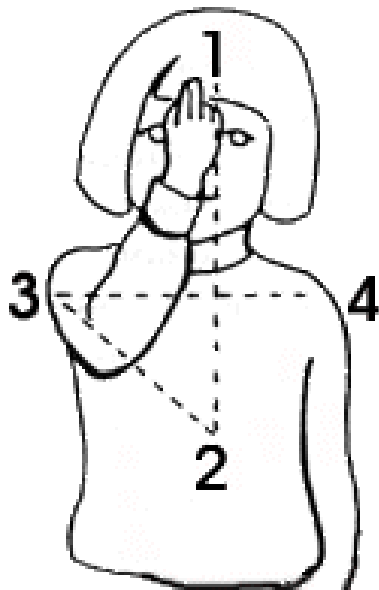


Sign of the Cross

Prayer to the Guardian Angel

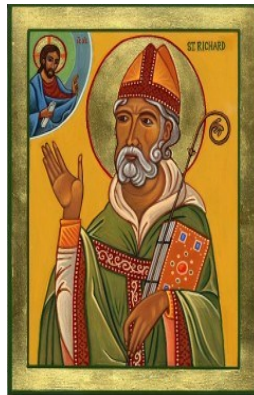
God gave each one of us an angel to look after us. We cannot see him but we can pray to him. This is a prayer to your angel.

3. The Crowning with Thorns.
4. The Carrying of the Cross.
5. The Crucifixion.
