School Uniform Policy 2021 - 2022 Reception



Aims and Objectives

Our School Uniform is important to us. It is one way in which we identify ourselves as a family and it promotes a strong, cohesive school identity which supports high standards and expectations in all areas of school life. It promotes harmony between different groups represented in school and it enhances security. The uniform has been chosen following consultation with governors and staff. It reflects the needs of the cultural traditions represented at our school.

At Ss Peter & Paul Catholic Primary School, the governing body implements the school uniform policy. A school uniform is important, because it:

- Promotes a sense of pride in the school
- Provides a feeling of community and belonging
- Is practical and smart
- Identifies the children with the school
- Makes children feel equal to their peers in terms of appearance
- Has been designed with health and safety in mind

When is a uniform required?

Children are required to wear the uniform to school at all times for pupils in Reception to Year 6. All pupils must wear the uniform when representing the school at events off school property as children are at all times ambassadors for the school. Pupils should wear their PE uniform or games kit when they are representing Ss Peter & Paul sporting events.

The Role of Parents

We ask all parents who send their children to Ss Peter & Paul Catholic Primary School to support our uniform policy. We believe that parents have a duty to send their children correctly dressed and ready for the day ahead. One of the responsibilities of parents is to ensure that their child has the correct uniform, and that it is clean and in good repair.

Jewellery

Pupils with pierced ears may wear a pair of small stud-earrings but they will need to be removed or covered for PE lessons. In addition, we do allow older children to wear a

sensible watch but no other items of jewellery can be worn. Long hair is to be tied back.

Children must not wear make-up or nail polish.

Footwear

We ask children to wear black shoes. Trainers are not to be worn to school.

Trainers are only appropriate for sports or leisurewear and are not in keeping with the smart appearance of our school uniform. Shoes must be sensible for both

learning and play time. Strapless shoes, flip-flops and shoes with high heels are not allowed.
