## RWI (English)

- Set 1 and 2 sounds.
- Blending and segmenting words orally.
- Reading red words (tricky words) by sight.
- Writing using our phonic sounds.
- Using finger spaces, capital letters and full stops.
- Writing sentences independently.
- We will also re-tell the story 'The Tiger who came to tea.'

## Mathematics

- Comparing and ordering numbers to 10.
- Addition and Subtraction within 10.
- Number bonds within 10.
- Solving picture and story problems.
- Positional language; first, second, last, left, right, next to, between.

## Religion

- Learn the story of creation.
- Take part in celebrations that give thanks and praise.
- Understand that there are different celebrations throughout the year.
- Know that Jesus taught people how to live through parables.



## Science

- Name the parts of the body.
- Name some of the internal organs.
- Name the five senses.
- Know what animals need to survive.
- Know what herbivores, omnivores and carnivores are.
- Name common reptiles, amphibians, mammals, fish and birds.
- Observe the changing seasons.



## Art and Design

- Create a variety of marks with different media.
- Produce observational drawings.
- Produce a self-portrait in various mediums.
- Create a collage of our own personal world.

## Topic

- Learn human and physical features in our local area.
- Explore the area we live in and to know that we live within the wider community of Coventry and the UK.
- Learn about timelines.
- Understand that there is a past, future and present.

## PE

- Jumping, through games and key skills with equipment.
- Dance; to be able to use their bodies to move in different ways and move to music.
- Balance skills and agility.
