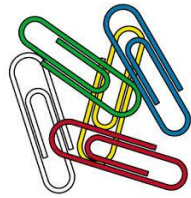


Year 5 Autumn Curriculum Overview



Outlined are the main topics that we will be learning about during the Autumn term. Please don't hesitate to get in touch if you have any questions.

English

In Reading lessons, we will be reading Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone while in English, we will be focusing on some of the works of William Shakespeare, exploring both Macbeth and Romeo and Juliet. Within these areas, we will be consolidating and extending our learning to:

- use basic punctuation accurately
- develop descriptive writing
- use a range of sentence types
- show awareness of the reader

Our English work will have strong links to our Theme work on the Tudors giving us plenty of opportunities for cross curricular links.

Mathematics

This term, our key objectives in Maths will be:

- Consolidating knowledge of place value up to 6 digits.
- Comparing and rounding numbers.
- Adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing numbers up to 1,000,000.
- Finding factors and multiples of different numbers.
- Understanding and using our mathematical knowledge to tackle problem solving.

These are some of the key objectives for Maths in year 5. There will be many other objectives which will be covered over the year.



Religion

We will begin this term by exploring some of the key Bible stories from both the Old and the New testament. We will start by focusing on the creation story and will reflect on the talents and gifts we have been given by God, considering how these can help others around us.

Science

This term, we will begin by looking at Space. We will be learning about the Earth as part of the wider solar system and will be examining how the movement of the Earth creates the days, years and seasons we are familiar with. The children will also work scientifically by making models to gain an idea of the size of the planets and the distances between them. They will also use a range of graphs and diagrams to record their ideas.

Theme

Our theme this term will be the Tudors. Throughout the term, we will examine the Tudors from a range of perspectives. We will become historians as we examine Tudor artefacts and understand key dates throughout the era. We will become geographers, considering how Cristopher Columbus would have felt upon discovering the West Indies. We will also look at different aspects of Tudor lifestyle such as art, design, architecture, food and clothing. Later in the term, we will also be exploring what Tudor life was like in Coventry and the surrounding areas.

Art, Design Technology (DT) and Music



A range of art and design technology skills will be taught through our Tudor theme. In particular, we will be looking at Tudor portraits and will be exploring the proportions of the human face to help us draw accurately. We will use a variety of pencils, pens and oil pastels to create to create some amazing artwork.

For music, we will be using the Oak Academy music scheme to help develop our understanding of rhythm and musical terms.

PE

Our PE lessons this term will focus on developing our indoor athletics, tag rugby and netball skills. PE this term will be on Mondays and Fridays.

PSHE

This term, we will be looking at how God cares for us and in turn, how we can show that we care for others both through our words and actions.

Languages

This term, we will be learning the alphabet before focusing on descriptive language. We will also learn how to count up to 69.
